

The Project: 2009 Summer TV 34 Internship

Sponsors: Montclair Arts Council (MAC) TV-34, Trinity Presbyterian Church, Montclair Board of Education, Montclair State University

Goal: To collaborate with the Township of Montclair and industry professionals to create a summer internship opportunity for **14** Montclair High School students.

Rationale: These internships would provide students with authentic experiences and hands-on opportunities in the area of film/video and communication.

Who can apply: This program is open to rising high school Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors.

Where: Montclair Municipal Building, 205 Claremont Avenue, Montclair and on the campus of Montclair State University. In addition, there may be some class time at MHS. Field trip opportunities will be a part of the program.

Dates: July 6 – July 24

Time: 9AM – 1:00PM - Any meeting time after 1:00PM would be at the discretion of the student, parent/guardian and the Channel 34 sponsor.

Benefits:

1. Students would learn the skills of hands-on professional digital camera use, audio, reporting, editing and use of mass media production equipment.
2. Final assignment to produce a small segment that will air on TV-34
3. Gain exposure to a career options in film/video
4. Receive mentoring from working professionals

How to apply?

1. Complete the attached application by Friday, June 19th. All applications must have a teacher and parent/guardian signature.
2. Applications are to be submitted to Ms. Tannous, MHS Film teacher or to the Montclair Arts Council 205 Claremont Avenue.
